2 Sat	WEST MOORS MEMORIAL HALL CPExp OL22 GR SU 078 0329 mls Holt Heath and environs farms circuit. Clayford, Candlewick, Crooked Withies, Paradise, Holt Lodge, Earleys, Newmans Lane farms. Woodland, heath and farmland. Via footpaths, bridleways, some tarmac. Some mud very likely. 2 stiles.
5 Tues	WEST MOORS MEMORIAL HALL CPExp OL22 GR SU 078 0324.2 mls Lions Hill nature reserve loop via Castleman Trailway, Moors River railway bridge and farm level crossing. Return partly back along trailway and then via West Moors plantation. Mostly level walking on gravel and some tarmac through village, with the exception of a circa 30 ft uphill rise footpath around Lions Hill wood. No stiles.
6 Wed	BEACHCOMBER CAFE, Barton on SeaExp OL22 GR SZ 239 929Triangular area where Marine Drive becomes Marine Drive East. Roadside parking or CP5.5 mls along the beach and the cliff path then out to Downton and back over the golfcourse.
8 Fri	POTTERS WHEEL CPExp 118 GR SU 087 0919.5 mls up and over Stephens Castle, meander through Ringwood Forest crossing over into Moors Valley at Ebblake South heading for lunch at the lookout. Returning through the park, Potterne Wood, Ebblake Ind Estate, to Noon Hill and back thru' Stephens Castle.
10 Sun	SHELL BAY NT CP & ToiletsExp OL22 GR SZ 034 8628 or 10 mls following the 600 mile SW Coast Path from its start at South Haven Point for itsfirst 8 miles to Swanage sea front, then return by bus to the walk start point. See below forfurther details **

12 Tues	WHITESHEET CPExp 118 GR SU 048 0363.5 mls circular walk around Holt Heath.
13 Wed	SHAPWICK CHURCH CPExp 118 GR ST 937 0175.7 mls over farmland and droves to Tarrant Crawford returning along the Stour Valley Way. Several stiles.
16 Sat	ASHMORE POND Park roadside near pond. Exp 118 GR ST 913 178 w3w///masterful.worth.sagging 10.5 mls Well Bottom, Tarrent Gunville and back via Ashmore Wood.
19 Tues	PAMPHILL GREEN CPExp 118 GR ST 990 0073.5 mls anti-clockwise loop passing Lacy Church, a section along the river Stour and incorporating open Meadowland,. Mostly flat with 5 'V' shaped stiles. Can be muddy after rain.
20 Wed	POTTERNE PARK CP (Tennis Courts)Exp OL22 GR SU 096 0745 mls taking in MV Viewpoint and Visitor Centre.Exp OL22 GR SU 096 074
22 Fri	SHAFTESBURY, LINDEN PARK Exp 118 GR ST 871 228 Park roadside Linden Park/Mampitts Road 9.2 mls Wincombe Park and the Donheads.
24 Sun	 CHIP SHOP BUS STOP, Manor Road, Verwood Exp OL22 GR SU 088 083 Park in Morrisons CP or Springfield Road 7.5 mls linear walk to Ringwood via Three Cross pub, through Woolsbridge Industrial Estate and on into Ringwood via Castleman Trailway. Back by X6 bus from Meeting House Lane 1.50 or 3.50.
26 Tues	POTTERNE PARK CP (Tennis Cts)Exp OL22 GR SU 096 0743 mls linear walk into West Moors with the option to visit a cafe, then return via X6 bus to Potterne park. Don't forget your bus pass.
27 Wed	JANESMOOR POND CPExp OL22 GRSU 247 1355.5 mls Fritham, Anses Wood, Cadman's Pool, South/North Bentley Inclosures.Some stiles.

2 Tues	KINGFISHER BARN CP, Granby Road, BournemouthExp OL22 GR SZ 096 9583.2 mls around Throop and Stour Valley Nature Reserve
3 Wed	RIVERLANDS CP, Wick Lane, ChristchurchExp OL 22 GR SZ 152 921Parking £4 for 4 hrs or free parking in adjacent side streets5 mls along the river then over Wiick fields to join the path up and over Hengistbury Head then back across the fields.
5 Fri	WEST LULWORTH Church Road. Exp OL15 GR SY 823 807 Park roadside and meet near church 8.5 mls Daggers Gate, Beacons, Durdle Door, Stair Hole and Lulworth Cove.
7 Sun	AVEBURY Ave/NEW Rd JUNCTION, Ensbury Dispersed parking along Avebury Ave, BH10 7EB, w3w///occurs.wings.brands 6.7 mls anti-clockwise loop of the Stour Valley Way to Throop Mill then skirting the airport and golf club through Parley Court with no stiles and flat but muddy if wet.
9 Tues	POTTERNE PARK CP (Tennis Cts)Exp OL22 GR SU 096 0743.7 mls circular walk to Three legged Cross via the horse paddocks, bridleway etc.
10 Wed	CRANBORNE GARDEN CTR (at top end)Exp 118 GR SU 056 132 (Consider a coffee or drink on return. Car share if possible)5.0 mls Burwood, Boveridge, Jack's Hedge Corner, Cranborne Fm, Manor Fm. Moderate undulating
13 Sat	BADBURY RINGS CP (no charge for NT members)Exp 118 GR ST 960 03110.4 mls north along tracks and footpaths to Manswood returning via Witchampton, King Down and the rings.

16 Tues	CRANBORNE GARDEN CTR (at top end) (Consider a coffee or drink on return) Exp 118 GR SU 056 132 w3w///hung.regretted.thighs
	3.5 mls Garden Centre, Penny's Lane, Mill Lane, Castle Hill Wood, Castle and back.
17 Wed	BURLEY CAR PARK (opposite cricket ground)Exp OL22 GR SU 214 0295.5 mls Turf Hill, Holmsley Ridge, Whitten Pond, Slap Bottom.Exp OL22 GR SU 214 029
19 Fri	MIDDLE WINTERSLOW CP, opposite Primary School SP5 1RD Exp 131 GR SU 237 328 7 mls linear walk along Clarendon Way to Salisbury Cathedral. Back via 88 bus from Endless Street 1.50/2.55/4.00.
21 Sun	WALKABOUT 5BLUEBELL WALK, Margards Lane, VerwoodExp OL22 GR SU 082 0826.5 mlsHorton Lane to Oakfield Farm then NW through Whitmoor into Boys Wood, over Sutton Common into Maldry Wood (early lunch sat among bluebells) then SE round Birches Copse across Romford over Crane Valley GC and Dewlands Common.
23 Tues	PAMPHILL GREEN CP (nearest the church)Exp 118 GR ST 990 0073.3 mls clockwise circuit passing St.Stephen's church, Pamphill, the River Stour and hoping to find some bluebells. 5 V stiles, and some steady inclines.
24 Wed	RINGWOOD ROAD, Ashley Heath by pedestrian footbridgeExp OL22 GR SU 122 038Service Road parallel to A31. Please park on one side of road only5 mls taking in Avon Heath Visitor Centre.
27 Sat	MARTIN DOWN NATURE RESERVEExp 118 GR SU 037 20210 mls Via Bower and Broad Chalke. One steep descent down Marleycombe Hill (poles advised if the weather has been wet) otherwise gently undulating and mainly on good tracks.
30 Tues	GARSTON/PRIBDEAN WOOD CP Exp 118 GR SU 003 195
	(Limited parking Car share if possible) 3.2 mls Upwood, Deanland, Newtown, Shermel Gate Undulating woods and fields.

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1 Wed	 HAMPTWORTH park opposite Cuckoo Inn (good for lunch) Exp OL 22 GR SU 244 196 w3w///slowness.remaining.intruding 5.1 mls along paths and farm tracks through woodland past Hamptworth Lodge returning through Langley Wood Nature Reserve.
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17 Fri	KINGSTON CPExp OL 15 GR SY 954 7959.0 mls clockwise to SW coast path, down Houns-tout then on to Kimmeridge for an extended lunch break in the vicinity of the Etches Collection for a chance to view the recently discovered Giant Sea Monster fossil (admission £9) then ridge walk back via Swyre Head.
19 Sun	SEA ROAD CAR PARK, Milford on SeaExp OL22 GR SZ 291 918Charges apply or free roadside nearby. Toilets in CP w3w///dragonfly.punch.tour5.5 or 10 mls walk around the back of Milford up to Newbridge Copse, towards Penningtonthen across to Keyhaven for lunch. Short walk back to Milford or along the sea wall and backvia the marshes.
21 Tues	NT KINGSTON LACY HOUSE & GROUNDS Exp 118 GR ST 978 039 (NT membership needed or entry fee will be charged) w3w///limo.youths.dares 3.2 mls gentle walk around the House's woodland walk. w3w///limo.youths.dares
22 Wed	HAWKHILL CP Exp OL22 GR SU 350 018 6.25 miles across heath to Hatchet Pond, past Furzey Lodge, through Rans Wood, Hawkhill Inclosure and Frame Wood, skirting Ladycross Inclosure and the edge of Beaulieu Heath before returning to Hawkhill.
25 Sat	HARDY MONUMENT NT CP free to NT members Exp OL15 GR SY 613 876 w3w: abundance.solve.headboard 9.2 mls - Hardy Monument, Black Down Barn, South Dorset Ridgeway, Abbotsbury, Macmillan Way, Tarrents Hill, Littlebredy, Smitten Corner.
28 Tues	POTTERNE PARK CP (Tennis Cts)Exp OL22 GR SU 096 0743.1 mls via Potterne Wood and the new trail to Crane Lake and on to Kingsmere Station returning via the boardwalk and causeway through the golf course.
29 Wed	CHARLTON MARSHALLExp 118 GR ST 901 040Lay-by on A350, South of Church, Limited Parking Car share if Possible. If lay-by full, dispersed parking in Church Lane, (opposite the Church)5.0 mls, Railway Path Spetisbury Rings, Home Plantation, Glebe & Manor Farms. 2 Gentle hills.
31 Fri	CRANBORNE GARDEN CTR (at top end) (Consider a coffee or drink on return)Exp 118 GR SU 056 1327 mls through and around Cranborne. Can be muddy.

** DETAILED Information for Sunday 10 March walk from Shell Bay NT CP TRAVEL TO THE START.

This is a great walk, but Shell Bay NT CP is a tricky meeting place to get to at the weekend so please allow extra time. The Sandbanks ferry will likely be busy, and cars may have to queue on approach. We meet up in the NT Shell Bay car park adjacent to the toilet block, whether arriving by road via Wareham, via chain ferry by car or by ferry as foot passenger. Entrance off the roundabout by the toll booth.

FERRY TIMES. Every 20 mins on the hour, 20 & 40 mins past. Or more frequently at peaks. Costs. Ferry: car £5.20 each way. Ferry: foot passenger £1 return. Car parking at Sandbanks is NOT recommended. See full price details online. Up to 6 hrs £16.50 Up to14 hrs £21.60 Another option is to park on a road in the vicinity of Canford Cliffs and walk to the ferry. And finally... If the Shell Bay NT carpark is full, one can park beside the road nearby.

WALKING CONDITIONS Variable terrain including beach sand, shallow stream crossings, tracks, cliff paths and some steep uphill stretches to Ballard Down, then steep downhill steps descending towards Swanage. Great views if the weather is fine. Depending on weather conditions, there is likely to be some slippery mud when descending towards Swanage promenade. Strenuous on the steep sections both going up and going down. Several public conveniences en route.

LUNCH STOP If weather permits there will be a lunch stop on Ballard Down overlooking the fine views across Swanage Bay and along the coast. Otherwise we will seek a more sheltered spot for a briefer lunch stop.

OPTIONAL EXTRA 2 MILES There's an option to return directly to the start point on the next available bus once we reach Swanage. Alternatively, depending on the time available, anyone who wishes to, may

continue to Peveril Point (an additional 2 miles return) by way of Forte's tea shop and/ or The Fish Plaice cafe on the corner of The Square and Mowlem Lane. (Details online) If there are any takers for these options we will decide on the day, and catch a later bus back to Shell Bay CP from the bus station or Banjo Pier stop.

RETURNING BY BUS from Swanage sea front to Sandbanks at a time of your choice. Bus Number 50. Six minutes past the hour, all day from Banjo Pier bus stop on Swanage sea front. Or from the nearby bus station in town on the hour. The number 50 stops at Shell Bay CP and goes onto the ferry for onward stops. The chain ferry runs until late.
